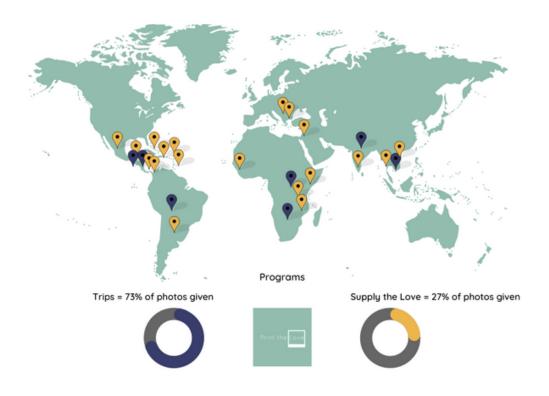
OUR STRATEGIES



We ensure photographs are given out in under-resourced communities through our 2 programs:

Service-Learning Volunteer Trips: We take teams of 4-6 travel to the world's lowest resourced countries to give away photos to schools, hospitals, maternity wards, markets, and slums. Trips cost around \$3K-\$4k. Fundraising is available for participants.

Supply the Love: Self-Trekking Ambassadors borrow a camera and the supplied film and give away photos on their own. Supply the Love is free and supported by donations.



LOVE TO TANIA





Each year we bring a team to at least 1 under-resourced country. This year 6 of us headed to the beautiful country of Tanzania. What an incredible gift it was to meet so many wonderful Tanzanians and partner with schools and NGOs. We gave away over 2,500 photos in schools, hospitals, and markets. We stayed in 4 different areas in Northern Tanzania (Meru, Arusha, Lake Natron, and Ikoma). We even got to experience Serengeti National Park. See our blog for the full trip impact and recap.



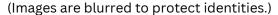
SUPPLY THE LOVE

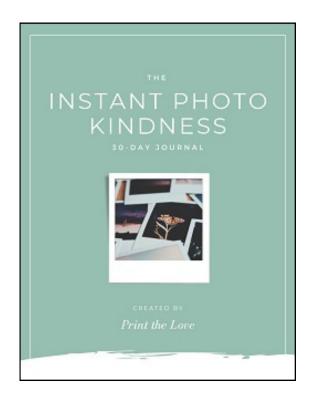

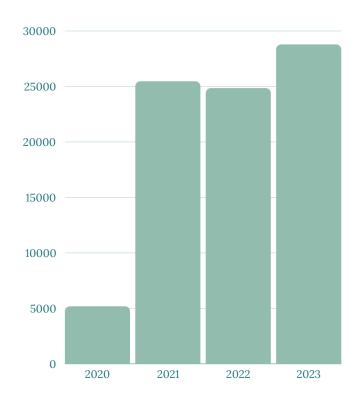
